



Safety and Risk Factors Reported By Victims

- 20% of people receiving advocacy services reported the perpetrator used a weapon, including a firearm against the victim.
- 27% of people receiving advocacy services had to relocate or became homeless as a result of domestic violence.
- of people receiving advocacy services who have been assaulted within the past 30 days who reported the presenting domestic violence experience to police

Impact Of Services Provided

- 73% of hotline callers reported the services received were helpful.
- 52% of children or their parents received safety planning specific to the children.
- 84% of adults who had at least one identified risk factor specific to domestic violence received safety planning.

Family Plans At Time Of Shelter Exit


Stable Housing = Self-Supported or Transitional Housing
